10:30–11:00	Press briefing on European health policy Health 2020, social determinates of health, and migration and health WHO experts will talk about the first progress report since Health 2020's launch in 2012, focus on social determinants of health and major health inequalities within and between countries; and will describe WHO's work on health and migration. <i>Press room</i>

10:30 –11:00	Press briefing on vaccination WHO experts will present the new European vaccine action plan 2015-2020, which is set to drive up immunisation rates and wipe out measles and rubella in the Region. <i>Press room</i>
13:00 – 13:30	Press briefing on child and adolescent health WHO experts will present the European Child and Adolescent Health Strategy 2015–2020 aimed at preventing ill health and death; and the new European Child Maltreatment Prevention Action Plan, which targets reduction of child maltreatment and child homicide rates by 20% by 2020. <i>Press room</i>
