
Deaths from NCDs 2011

Eastern Mediterranean	0.8
Europe	2.4
South-East Asia	4.2
Western Pacific	3.4
World	13.8





Years of life lost due to NCDs, 2010, all ages, both sexes, per 100 000



Years of life lost **with disability** due to NCDs, 2010, all ages, both sexes, per 100 000



SDR, diseases of circulatory system, all ages per 100000




SDR = standardized death rate


Gross domestic product, US\$ per capita







SDR, diseases of circulatory system, all ages per 100000




Current tobacco use in Europe – no room for complacency


