The European Region of the World Confederation for Physical Therapy (ER-WCPT), representing over 163,000 physical therapists & physiotherapists in Europe welcomes the *Strategy & action plan for Ageing in Europe*.

Physiotherapists are experts in promoting and prescribing physical activity programmes in prevention, maintenance, promotion and treatment across the lifespan [WCPT 2011, Policy statement: Physical therapists as exercise experts across the life span https://www.wcpt.org/policy/psexercise%20experts] and should be key contributors to healthy ageing over the life-course - particularly since many people present to physiotherapists in their 50's, the target group for 'early old age' and can be educated and empowered to be more active. Physiotherapists can encourage greater physical activity and empower people to exercise within any limitation they may have in order to improve health and fitness and minimize complications.

In the majority of states in Europe, physiotherapists are educated to be firstcontact, autonomous practitioners and work with patients/clients though their whole episode of care. The ER-WCPT urges national policy makers to ensure that physiotherapists are key professionals involved in the promotion of physical activity – where there is significant evidence of both the clinical and cost-effectiveness of exercise resulting from Physiotherapy intervention.
