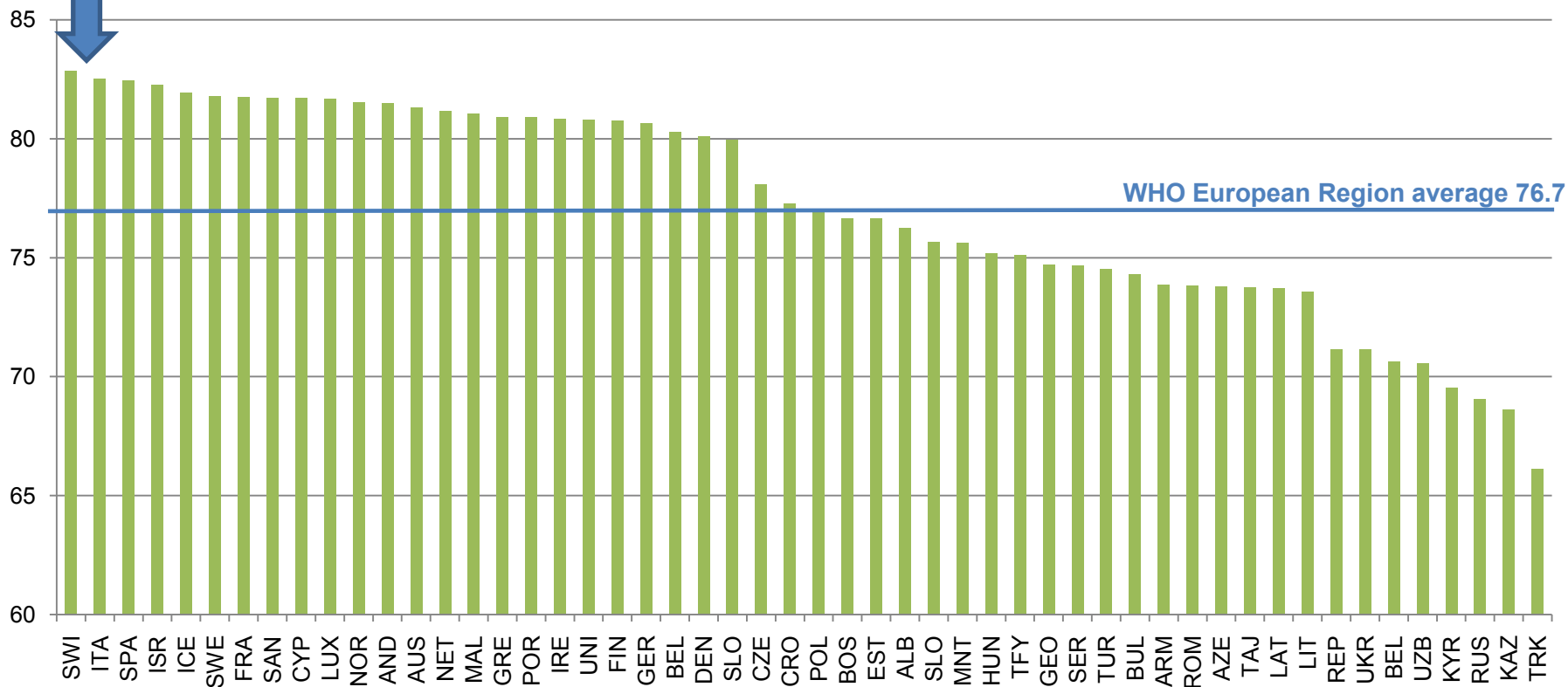

Italy has good health status

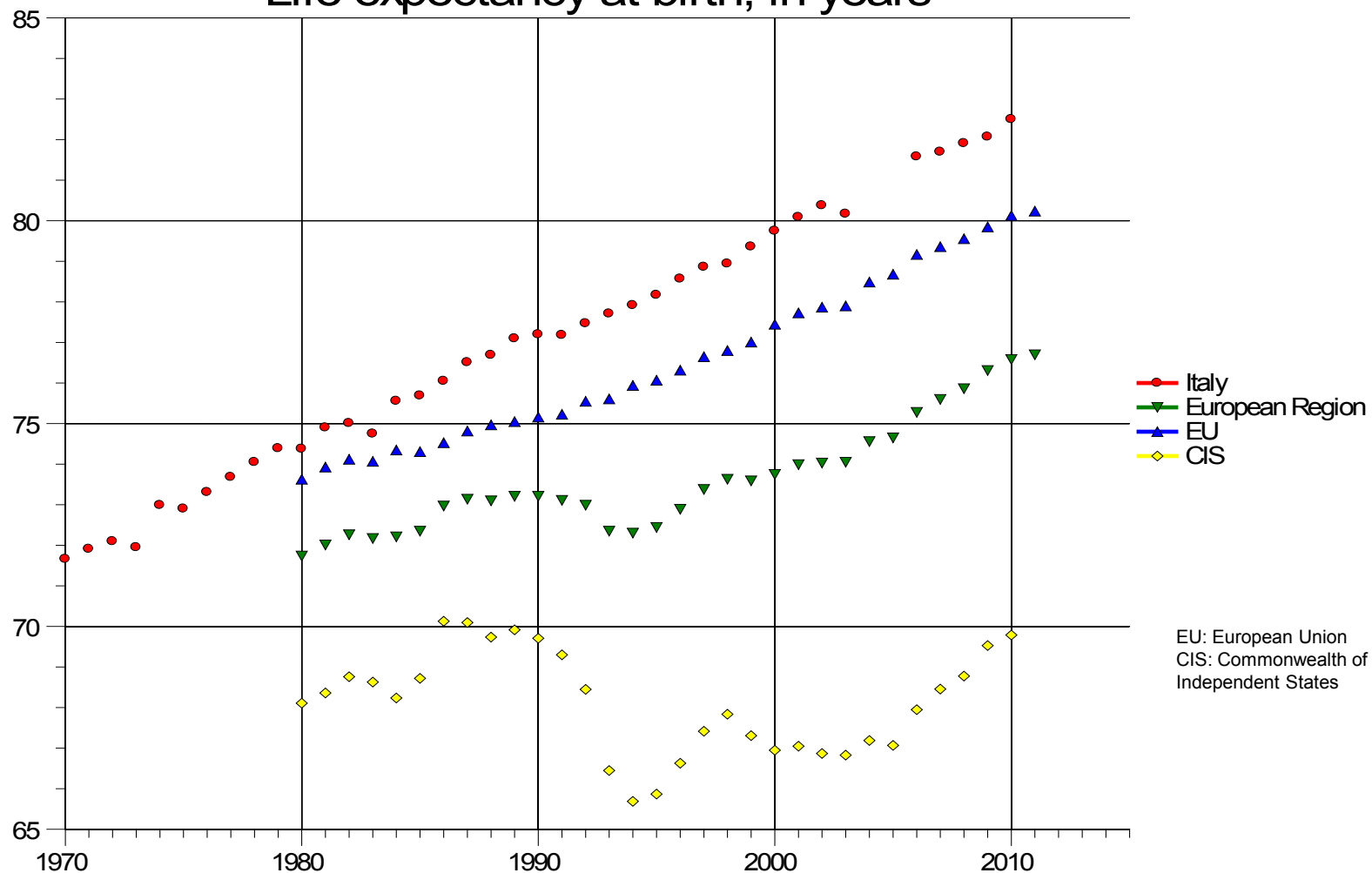
Life expectancy at birth in years in countries in WHO European Region

Life expectancy at birth, in years

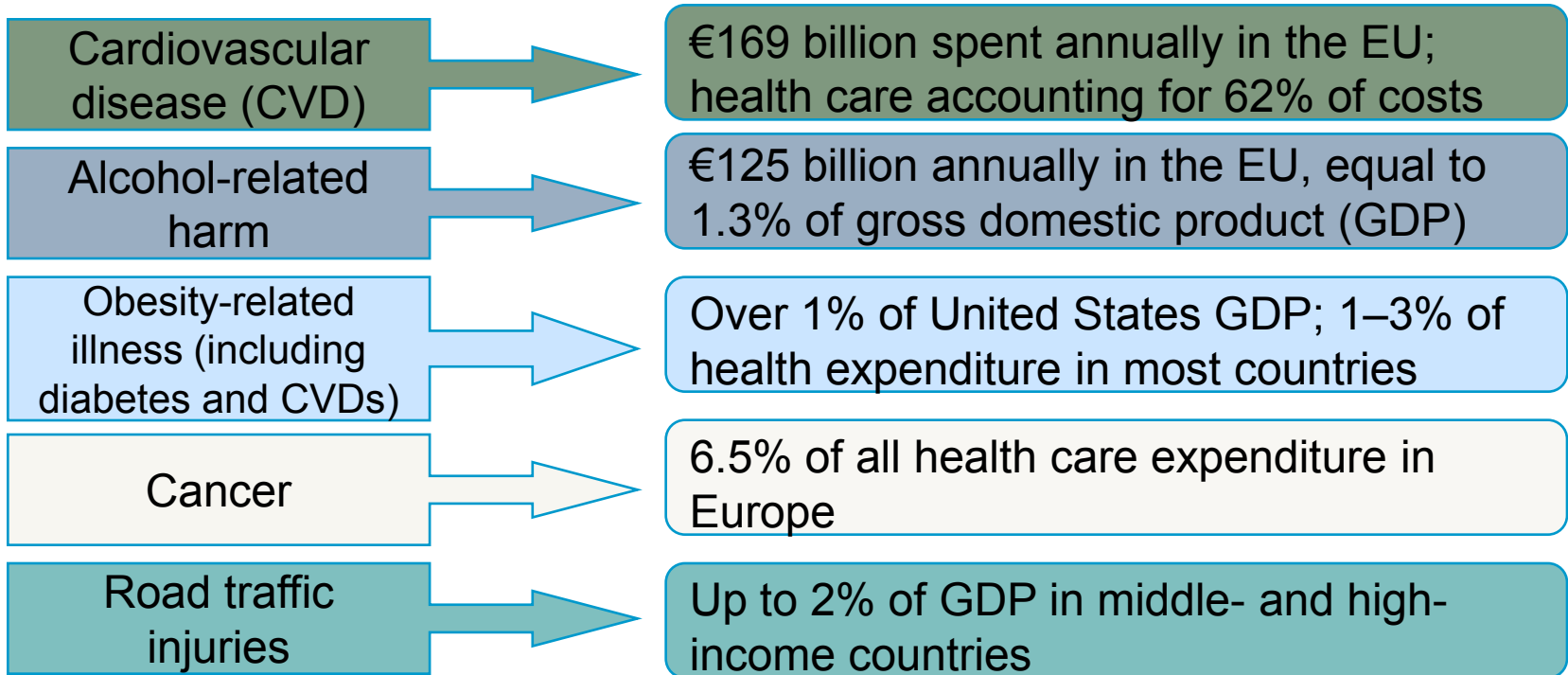

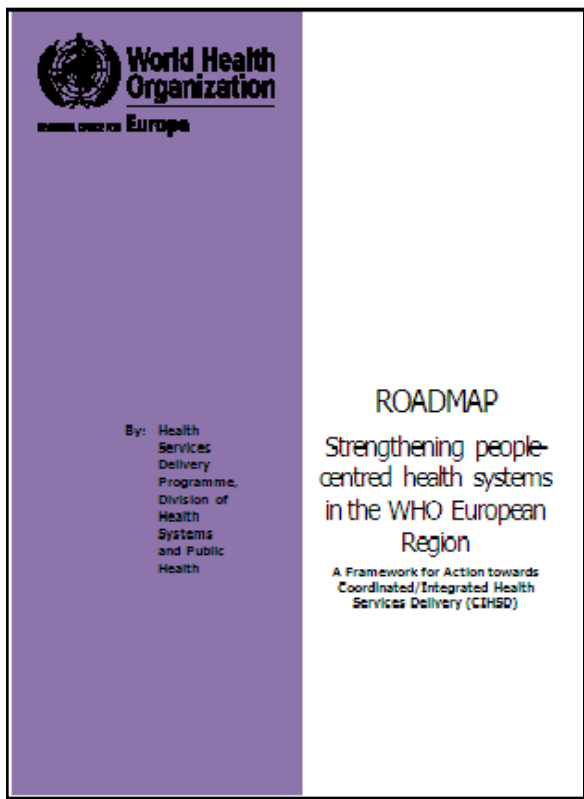
Health – a precious global good

Impact of health on economic growth

- 1% life expectancy increase = 6% GDP growth (Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development)
- 10% decrease in CVD = 1% per capita income growth (2009)
