



National plans for eliminating measles and rubella and preventing congenital rubella infections (CRI).

Eliminating measles and rubella and preventing congenital rubella infection, WHO European Region strategic plan 2005-2010 (2005) strongly encourages Member States to have approved national immunization plans for routine childhood immunization and disease-specific plans for measles, rubella and CRI. The development and regular review of these plans is consistent with Resolution EUR/RC55/R7 of the WHO Regional Committee for Europe, fifty-fifth session, 2005.

The following information for 2005 was obtained from data submitted to WHO Regional Office for Europe in 2006 by Member States using the *WHO/UNICEF Joint Reporting Form.* While 34 (61%) of 52 countries reported they had national immunization plans, 27 (52%) also had national plans for measles; however, fewer countries had plans for rubella and CRI.



This information provides a useful benchmark by which Member States commitment and progress to achieving the 2010 targets can be measured. The WHO Regional Office for Europe is aware that since 2005, a number of Member States have published or are in the process of developing these plans.
