At the request of the Ministry of National Resources of Hungary, WHO/Europe and ECDC organized a joint country visit 22–25 May 2012.

### Review of the national tuberculosis programme in Kazakhstan

The WHO/Europe TB and M/XDR-TB programme in collaboration with partners conducted an extensive review of TB prevention, control and care in Kazakhstan, 9–18 May 2012.

#### Review of the national tuberculosis programme in Azerbaijan

With financial support from the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (GFATM) and in collaboration with partners, the WHO/Europe TB and M/XDR-TB programme conducted an extensive review of TB prevention, control and care in Azerbaijan, 11–18 April 2012.

#### Workshops to update national M/XDR TB response plans

Turkmenistan, Armenia, Ukraine and Belarus have conducted workshops to update their national M/XDR TB response plans. The plans will soon be finalized and submitted to the respective ministries of health for approval.
