



Annual Meeting of Joint ECDC/WHO Surveillance Network for Tuberculosis

23-24 May 2011

Venue: NH Atlantic Hotel, Kijkduin, The Hague, Netherlands

Scope and purpose

Background

ECDC and the WHO Regional Office for Europe (the Regional Office) jointly coordinate TB surveillance in the Region. Both organizations agreed to share the data sent by the 54 countries, the activities deriving from the collection, validation, analysis and dissemination of information, and other tasks related to surveillance and monitoring of tuberculosis.

In order to perform these functions, a joint TB information system has been developed. A common reporting entry point has been set up for all the countries in the WHO European Region through a web page which has the logos of both organizations. TESSy and the Global TB data databases are used for the data collection, and data are validated and exchanged between ECDC and the WHO in order to avoid double reporting.

The focus of this year's Annual Meeting on TB Surveillance in Europe will be data quality and completeness. There will be presentations on how the information system operates regarding case-based and aggregated surveillance data, as well as data regarding TB management information.

The latest changes in TB data collection (HIV-TB, reporting to the global database, etc.) will also be reviewed during the meeting.

Participants will be asked to discuss the next Annual Surveillance and Monitoring Report in working groups and give feedback on developments and future changes.

Objectives

- To provide an overview of the TB epidemiological situation in the European Region;
- To discuss data quality and comprehensiveness and use of the data to assess the TB burden;
- To discuss the development and function and events of the Network.

Outcomes

- Participants are updated on the TB epidemiological situation and on the operations of the ECDC/WHO joint TB information system;
- Participants provide feedback on the implementation of the joint TB surveillance system, making proposals for possible changes in data collection and publication of the annual report.
